Dear Friends.

The GO team in the US continues to monitor the impact and response to the COVID-19 pandemic closely, staying in regular communication with our field staff in Senegal and Mexico.

- The pandemic-caused restrictions around the world do not mean the work of GO on the Mission has slowed or come to a stop. Absolutely not! In fact, the needs and opportunities are even greater to demonstrate the compassionate love of lesus during these times.
- In the initial months of the pandemic, because of the strong response of our wonderful and generous donors, GO was able to send significant aid to our partners in both Mexico and Senegal to address the areas of highest need keeping those in need fed, providing masks and sanitizing supplies to schools and feeding centers, and helping to support the staff of the Senegalese schools.
- With vaccines still months away from availability in Senegal and Mexico, ongoing aid is still vital for the children and families we serve. In Senegal, schools are back in session at the moment, but work is still scarce for adults, so we are working to provide relief for hungry families. In Mexico, the feeding centers have reopened, but we are still seeing record numbers, so we are working to support the centers as well as families in the neighborhoods with high needs.
